As every year - on August 1 at the "W" hour (5pm) - we will gather on Castle Square in Warsaw's Old Town, to commemorate the heroic fight of Warsaw's insurgents for independence, by creating together a "Live Symbol" - an anchor – the symbol of hope.

This year, due to the limitations related to the epidemic, the "Living Symbol" will be created

only by previously registered volunteers. Despite this current situation, we invite everyone to participate in this, the 7th edition of the "Live Symbol" for the Warsaw Uprising.
